

PAINT YOUR OWN FASHION!

What you'll need:

- Fabric paint (Pots and brushes OR fabric paint sticks)
- A pot of water to clean brushes if you are using pots of paint
- Plain T-Shirt or shoes (or any other plain clothes)
- Piece of cardboard

STEP 1

Wash and dry your fabric.

STEP 3

Create two yellow ovals and fill them in.



STEP 5

With a finer brush, outline the body and wings in black.



STEP 7

Add two little dots for eyes, and some dashes behind the bee to show it buzzing around.



STEP 9

Ask a parent for help! Place a piece of cloth over the design and iron for 3-5 minutes at 100°C to "fix" your artwork.

STEP 10

To wash, turn your garment inside-out and wash on a cold cycle.

STEP 2

Place a piece of cardboard inside the shirt to stop the paint from getting through to the other side.

STEP 4

Use blue to form two wings on the body (Make sure to clean your brush between colours if you are using fabric paint).



STEP 6

Add stripes to the body, making sure they are curved to give the illusion of a round body.



STEP 8

Once you are happy with your design, let it dry completely.
