What happened to the colours when you added water?

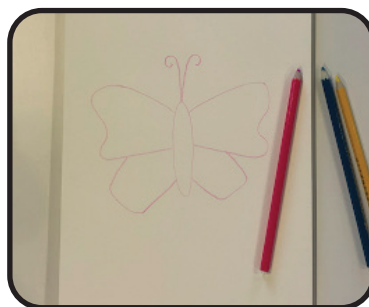
How did the colours change?

### STEP 1

Select 2 or more colours you would like to use for your butterfly (Here I have chosen pink, blue and yellow). Outline your butterfly using one of these colours.



### STEP 2

Use your colours to add stripes along the wings of your butterfly.



### STEP 3

Dip your paintbrush into some water and brush it across your first colour. What happens?



### STEP 4

Keep adding more water with the brush to the rest of your colours. Your colours might mix and create other colours. What other colours can you see?



### STEP 5

Outline your butterfly with a coloured marker. This can be any of the colours in your artwork already, or you can simply use black.



### STEP 6

OPTIONAL EXTRA: Add some details to your wings with your marker to make it look like a real butterfly.
